The video interview is designed to help employers get to know you a little better early in the process. When you receive an invite, you'll be directed to a landing page and guided through a series of pre-recorded video questions. Below are the questions included in a standard video interview.\*

<p>1. What type of things do you love doing in your current or past roles and why?</p>	<p>2. We all know no job is perfect and have things we don't enjoy doing so tell us what aspects of your current or past roles you have least enjoyed doing and why?</p>
<p>3. Tell us about one or more of your proudest moments or achievements at work. Make sure to go into detail.</p>	<p>4. What are the most important things to you in a job you're looking for today?</p>
<p>5. How important are good relationships at work and why?</p>	<p>6. And, taking that last question a step further, can you share an experience where you had to adapt or adjust your approach to a team members working style to deliver on a task or project outcome?</p>
<p>7. When you were at school, what interests or hobbies did you have and how have they influenced your career to date?</p>	<p>8. Outside of work, what interests and passions do you have?</p>
<p>9. What else would you like us to consider as part of your application?</p>	<p>*Please note, employers may vary these questions or add their own depending on the role they are hiring for.</p>
